### CARES Act Report

The Trinity Baptist College Administration assures the U.S. Department of Education, by signed Certification and Agreement, that Trinity Baptist College intends to use no less than 50 percent of funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act to provide emergency financial relief to students.

Trinity Baptist College received \$210,954.00 from the U.S. Department of Education, pursuant to the Administration's Certification and Agreement, for emergency financial relief to students. The Financial Aid Office estimates 137 students who could be eligible for a relief disbursement provided they experienced an emergency financial hardship defined under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

Trinity Baptist College evaluates student CARES Act Relief Applications and supporting documentation for emergency relief eligibility defined under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

As of July 16, 2020, Trinity Baptist College distributed a total of \$24,110.00 to 29 students who meet the financial hardship requirement and provided supporting documentation to demonstrate individual emergency costs related to the disruption of campus operations.
